## TRANSPLANTED TWICE

<sup>7</sup> He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God.

## Revelation 2:7 [NKJV]

n the center of the garden of Eden, God planted a tree. On the entire planet, ONE TREE was forbidden!

"Knowledge of good and evil"

Deciding for yourself what is good or bad belongs to God. Don't eat of it! That fruit will kill you!
